#### A Card Game for the Whole Family at the Passover Seder


A Passover Seder Game for the Whole Family

This game can be played in stages, so you can stop and start and enjoy a round at any point during the Passover seder.

#### **How to Play**

- Place the cards facedown in a pile.
- Each player, in turn, withdraws a card from the deck and follows the instructions on it.
- It is recommended and the most fun to follow the instructions with other people around the table.






Exodus from Egypt!

Which **three things** would you take with you?


## PJ Library

Stand on one leg and say **five** things about Passover. You can ask for help from other people around the table.



## PJ Library

You are the **bird** that comes to visit baby Moses in his basket. Tell everyone about your meeting with Moses. You can fly and chirp!




## PJ Library

*Le'Hayim*! At the seder we drink four cups [of wine or grape juice].

Who would you like to toast?

Passover is also called the Holiday of Spring. Buzz like a **bee** and fly around the table.

#### PJ Library




Exodus from Egypt! You are leaving Egypt! Which song would you **sing along** the way to make the journey more fun?

Ask everyone to join in.

Do you like to eat **maror** (bitter herbs)? Try to convince everyone that it is the tastiest thing in the whole world!




#### PJ Library

Who's a **frog**? Hop like a frog from the plague of frogs. Who is ready to hop with you?

It's so dark! Act out the plague of **darkness**.
What do you see?
What might you bump into?

## PJ Library



Why do we ask **questions**? Choose something on the table and ask everyone as many questions about it as you can. Ask them to think of more questions.

WHO KNOWS




Who knows one?

Count the people sitting around the seder table.



Ask everyone at the table to tell you why this year, the **seder** is different from all other years.




#### PJ Library

**Spring** has arrived - Passover is here! Sing a song about spring or Passover and ask everyone to join in.




#### PJ Library

In a **hurry** to leave Egypt? Pretend that you are about to be freed from slavery: What would you say? What would you do?




#### PJ Library

What does **skipping** over something have to do with the Passover story? Do you know how to skip? Skip around the seder table three times.




## PJ Library



**Hail** came down on Egypt. Tell everyone what you could do with all that ice.


## PJ Library

Off we go! Tell the people of Israel why they should **hurry up** and leave Egypt.




## PJ Library

Who knows **three**? Look at everything on the table and see if there is something there at least three times.




#### PJ Library

The **Animal** Choir is about to sing! Make sounds like the animals in the Had Gadya song: Bleat like a goat, meow like a cat, bark like a dog...




## PJ Library



**Lice** are a plague! Act out the third plague how do lice make you feel, and what do you do?


# PJ Library

The **matzah** is out! Convince the people of Israel that it's not so bad that the dough didn't rise. Matzah is better!

What will we eat on the way? Hurry up and show everyone how you knead the **dough** before you leave Egypt.

"We are all **smart** and we are all **wise**" - ask the people around the table to tell you the ways in which you are smart.

PASSOVER MATZAH



Raban Gamliel says everyone has to say these three things on Passover:

**Passover, matzah, and maror.**Sing out those three words and dance at the same time.

**Hum** a Passover song and see who can guess which one it is.





What do you **like best** about Passover? Tell the other people at the table and ask them what they like best.




## PJ Library
